

Dramatic Play Plan

Fall: Firefighter

MATERIALS

- ✓ Candle
- ✓ Caution Tape
- ✓ Fireman Costumes
- ✓ Helmets
- ✓ Badges
- ✓ Emergency Fire Plan
- ✓ Smoke detector
- ✓ Fire hose
- ✓ Flashlight
- ✓ Fire axe
- ✓ Walkie-Talkie
- ✓ Fire extinguisher
- ✓ Telephone

SETUP

1. Set up house area where the fire will start.
2. Set up a fire station where the Fireman and fire truck will be.
3. Set up a Police Station where the Policeman will be when he answers the 9-1-1 call.

ROLES:

- Mom or Dad
- Policeman
- Fireman

Intro: *“Once upon a time there was a mom were lit a candle and then went to bed. A four hours later they woke up, and oh no, they smelled smoke! They quickly ran to their telephone and called 9-1-1. Firefighters and policemen were sent to the house and began to put out the fire. They rescued the family in the house!”*

Today we are going to pretend to be fighting a fire! You can be the Mom or Dad who finds the fire and calls 9-1-1, the Policeman (or woman), who answers the 9-1-1 calls and tells the Fireman where the fire is, or the Fireman, who drives to the house, rescues the people, and puts out the fire.”

ACTIVITY 1 – HOUSE FIRE

The mom or dad pretends to light a candle and then leaves the room or goes to bed. They wake up to a smoke alarm going off, call 9-1-1, and leave the house.

The policeman answers the 9-1-1 call. After asking for their address, he drives to the house with the firefighters.

ACTIVITY 2 – FIGHTING THE FIRE

The firefighters pretend to spray the fire with their hoses. The policeman make sure the family is okay.

Expansions

- Practice stop, drop, and roll.

ACTIVITY 3 – ESCAPE PLAN

Make a pretend escape plan in case of future fires, earthquakes, etc.
